

Planning and Zoning Commission –
Member Seats Available

The City Council announced at its October 13th meeting an opportunity for those interested in city planning activities in Montgomery to apply for seats that need appointment to the City's Planning and Zoning Commission. Applicants are required to live in the city limits. All members of the Board are residents of the City.

The Board members act on behalf of the City in administering development efforts of the city, including review of subdivision plats and hearing sign and painting permits for the historic area. The Commission also has the role of providing help to the City Council regarding city planning efforts including street locations, master planning of the city and other planning efforts as assigned by the City Council

The Board meets monthly, on the fourth Monday of the month at 6:00 p.m. at city hall in Montgomery. There is no pay for the service on the Commission. Applications can be found on montgomerytexas.gov website, click city government, then click Boards and Commissions then click "Membership Application" and forward the application to City Secretary Susan Hensley at shensley@ci.montgomery.tx.us or bring the completed application to city hall at 101 Old Plantersville Road. Applications are due November 4th, 4:00 p.m.
