## **Candidate Forum Scheduled for Montgomery**

## **City Council Position Races**

The Montgomery Area Chamber of Commerce (Chamber) and the Voter Awareness Council (VAC) are pleased to announce that they are co-hosting a non-partisan, unbiased candidate forum on Thursday, April 8, 2021, 7:00 pm at the Lone Star Community Center building located at 2500 Lone Star Pkwy in Montgomery.

**Place 1** incumbent Carol Langley and candidate Jenny Stewart, **Place 3** incumbent TJ Wilkerson and candidate John Champagne, Jr.; and **Place 5** incumbent Tom Cronin and candidate Byron Sanford have all been invited. Early voting will begin April 19. Election Day is May 1. Chamber and VAC officials will be co-hosting and introducing the session but will have no role in the actual forum.

Anna Lotz, Editor of the *Community Impact Newspaper* – Conroe / Montgomery Edition will act as forum moderator. Anna will use questions based on the media's overall awareness of Montgomery area issues, questions submitted to her from anyone prior to the session via email at info@montgomeryareachamber.com, and written questions submitted by the audience during the early stages of the forum.

Candidates will make opening and closing remarks, answer questions in a round robin question format, and have the opportunity to comment on all questions. Reasonable time constraints will apply throughout the session.
